Area 55's 8<sup>th</sup> Unity Day will be held on July 29, 2023, at the First United Methodist Church, 1526 E. Wooster St., Bowling Green, OH between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00p.m. Doors will open at 8:00 a.m. with a light breakfast available and a light lunch will

follow the event allowing time for fellowship and friends. Why do we have a special time set aside?

What is Unity Day about? Area 55 has 263 active, in-person meetings and 7 virtual meetings registered with the General Service Office. Like any groups gathered for a single purpose, Unity Day allows the area fellowship to identify our strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats. If well attended, Unity Day is an opportunity to review how all those groups are doing. There have been many ways our Area has gone about this during these 8 years. Upon occasion, the Delegate has shared their experience of attending the General Service Conference held in New York. This day of reflection is only as strong as you make it. The first Unity Day was held in Bowling Green, but the facility was too small. There were roughly 125 members in attendance for the first one. The second event was held at the First United Methodist Church in Bowling Green. We also had a good showing that year. A couple of years we used the Traditions Checklist to take an Area Inventory.

A couple of years we used the time to introduce the next Area Delegate with their lead. We have asked General Service Representative's (GSR's) on a panel to speak about their experience serving a home group; District Committee Members (DCM'S) to speak about their experiences and growth. Unity Day was held online in 2020 during the Covid Pandemic. But, in 2021 it was held in person at Providence Lutheran Church. Attendance was low as people were still hesitant to gather in large groups. We again conducted a SWOT analysis of Area 55's health. Survival of Alcoholics Anonymous and Area 55 was a topic of concern. We have returned to Bowling Green these past two years. Bowling Green was chosen as being more centrally located for the Area. We are still trying to unify this area, to demonstrate that there is a strength within the area that comes from gathering our experiences, reviewing what the area is doing well; what can be improved; what opportunities are still waiting to be developed within the area and what threats might be in the area. My invitation to you is to attend this event on July 29<sup>th</sup> and bring a friend, a sponsee, bring a group member or two, pick someone up that isn't able to drive and bring them. Let's, you and I fill the auditorium.
