GSO Quarterly Report: First Quarter 2025

- 2024 saw \$11,252,155 in contributions, surpassing the previous annual contributions record (2023) by over \$400,000
- 2024 gross literature sales were \$14,452,563, which is over \$2,300,000 below the forecast amount.
- 2024 total operating revenue was \$19,682,054, which is ~0.1% above budget
- 2024 total operating expenses before depreciation was \$18,686,132, roughly
 0.6% below budget

 - February 2025 set the post-pandemic single month literature gross sales record
- GSO Corrections Desk Activity Update


